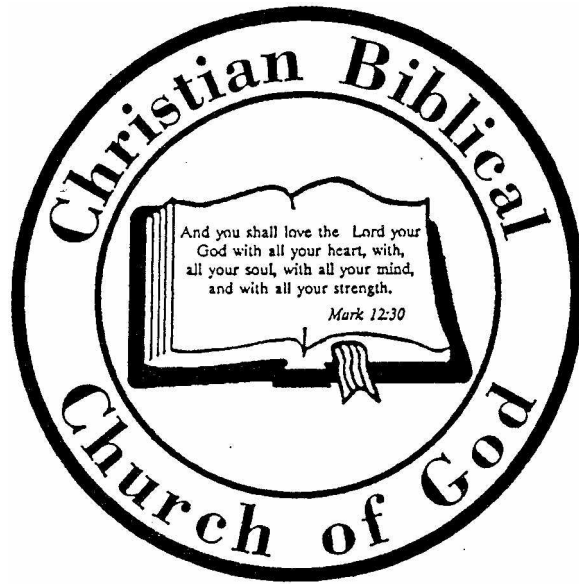

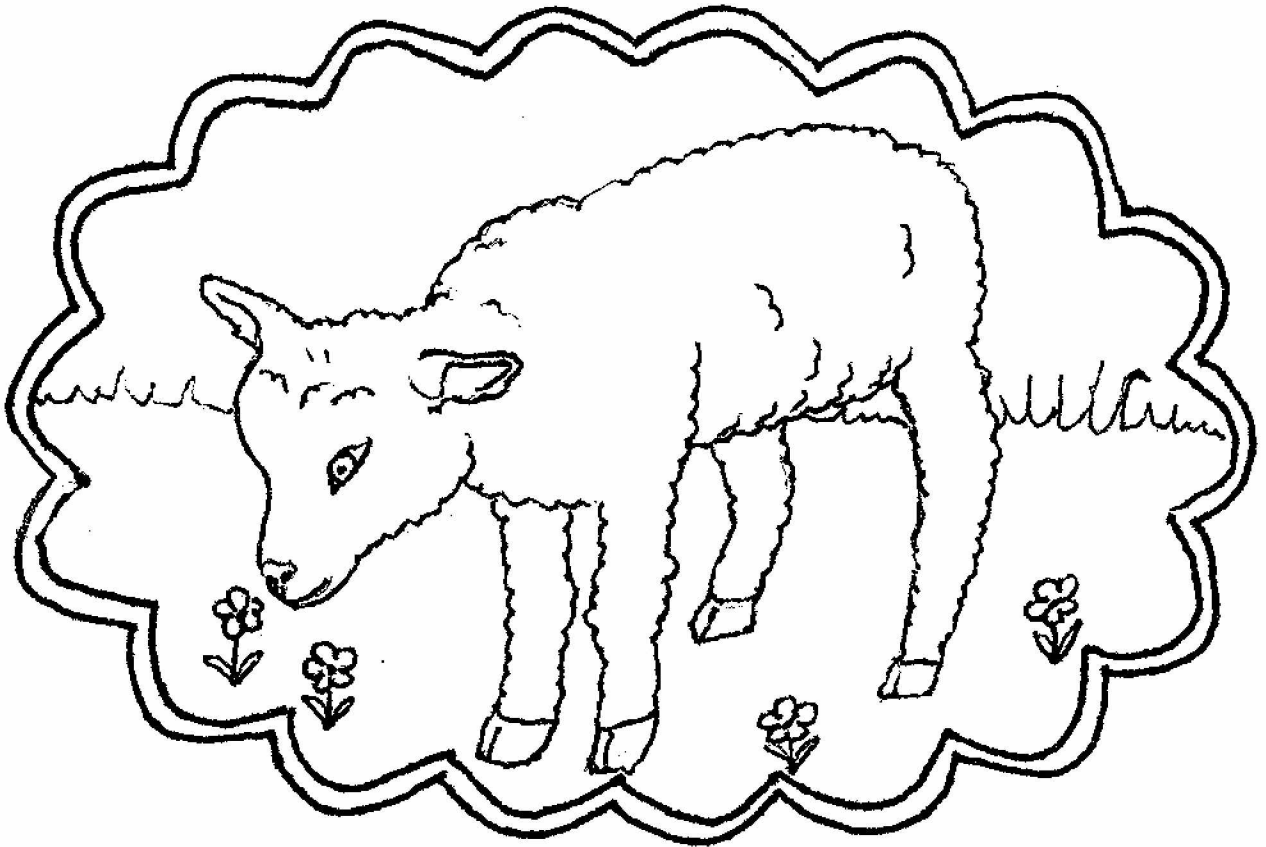

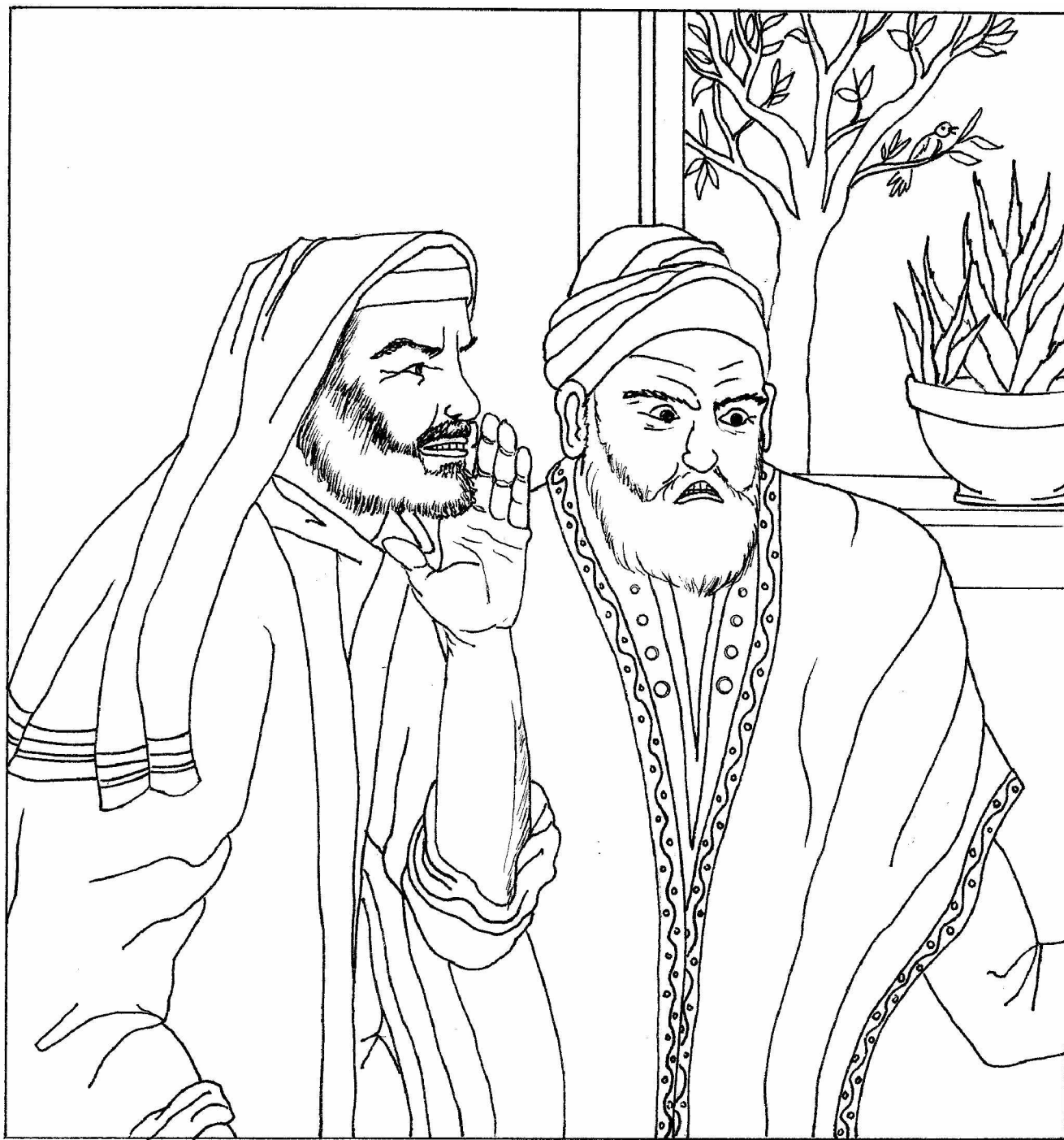

There is one that is making himself rich, yet has nothing: there is one that is making himself poor, yet has great riches. Proverbs 13:7

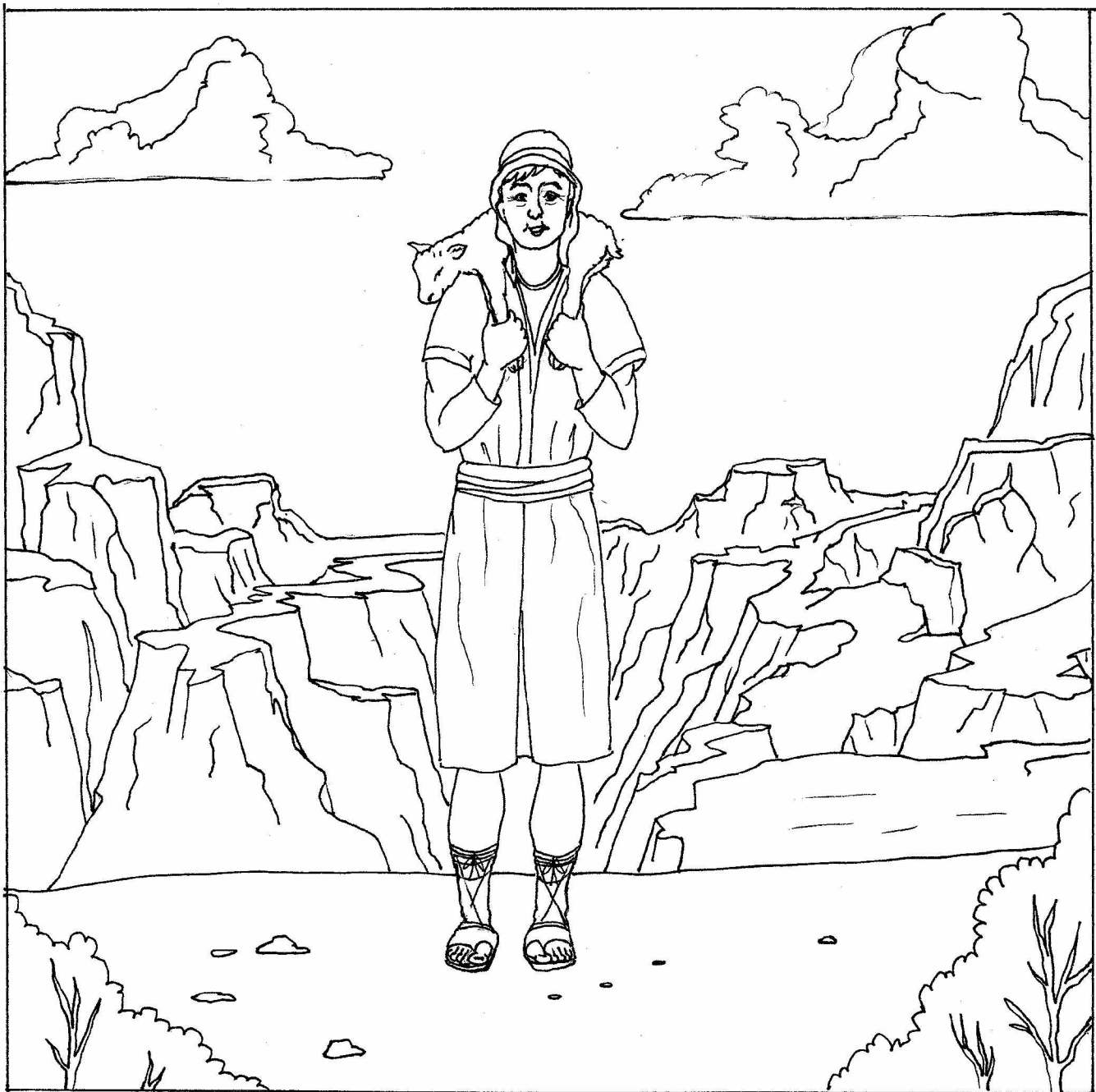

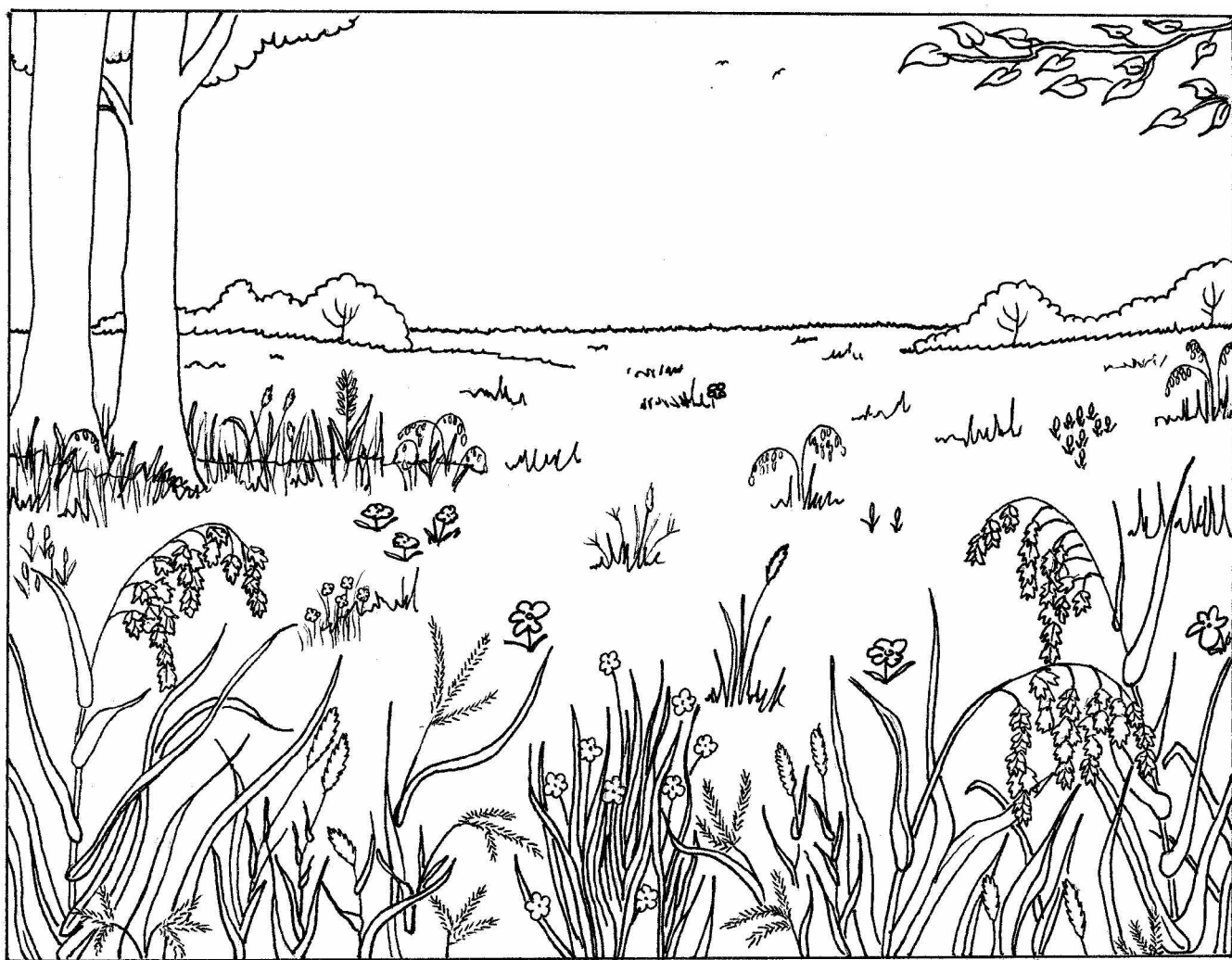
"But as for you, seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you." Matthew 6:33
