Feast of Tabernacles and Last Great Day 2006 October 7-October 14

Dear Brethren,

We have been delayed in getting this Feast Letter out to you because I have been traveling extensively. Here is the information packet for the **Feast of Tabernacles 2006**. Because of the high price of gasoline and cost of traveling, we have added several new Feast sites. Please pay special attention to the instructions.

Please be sure to return the Feast Information Sheet as soon as possible.

Each one is responsible to make his or her own reservations. In all locations, please mention that you are with the Christian Biblical Church of God, because in most cases we have been given special rates. Remember that the Feasts of God are as important as the weekly Sabbath. Moreover, through keeping them, year by year, we are able to learn and understand more about God's plan as revealed in the Bible. We pray that this year's Feast will be the best ever for you and your family.

General Feast Information:

We need your help. Over the years it has been our policy to let people go where ever they wanted and change their mind as often as they like. Some even wait until a few days before opening night of the Feast before making housing reservations.

However, as more and more hotels and motels are making the bottom line [profit] rather than service be their main focus they are becoming more stringent on meeting the condition of the contract. In order to negotiate special room rates and to obtain meeting rooms at no cost or a reduced cost we have to guarantee a minimum number of rooms. In the past they would often give us the same rates for the guestrooms and the meeting room even when we dropped below our guarantee. With the increased focus on profit and a stronger economy they are not as willing to overlook minor deficiencies between the actual number of rooms booked and the number of rooms contracted and have starting charging extra fees when we drop below the contractual requirement. For example last year at one location we dropped below the minimum number of rooms and the management increased the cost of the room. Rather than pass that increase on to the feast

attendees and possibly have them exceed their budget the church picked up the difference. We would like to avoid having this extra cost at any of the sites this year.

At the larger feast sites meeting our contractual guarantee has never been a problem because they always exceed the guaranteed minimum. The other festival sites do not have guaranteed minimums so they do not have a problem.

We hope you will join us for the Feast of Tabernacles 2006 in Virginia Beach, Virginia. We will again be meeting at the Howard Johnson's located at 1801 Atlantic Avenue, Virginia Beach, VA, 23451, 757-437-9100. The Howard Johnson Hotel has rooms available at a discount for the brethren.
