

cerning Jesus the Nazarean, a man Who was a prophet, Who was mighty in deed and word before God and all the people;
20. And how the chief priests and our rulers delivered Him up to *the* judgment of death, and crucified Him.

21. And we were hoping that He was the one Who would redeem Israel. But besides all these things, as of today, the third day has already passed since these things took place.*

22. And also, certain women from among us astonished us, after they went to the tomb early;

23. For when they did not find His body, they came *to us*, declaring that they had indeed seen a vision of angels, who said, 'He is living.'

24. And some of those with us went to the tomb and found *it* exactly as the women had said, but they did not see Him."

25. Then He said to them, "O foolish and slow of heart to believe in all that the prophets have spoken!

26. Was it not necessary for the Christ to suffer these things, and to enter into His glory?"

27. And beginning with Moses, and from all the prophets, He interpreted to them the things concerning Himself in all the Scriptures.

28. And *as* they approached the village where they were going, He appeared to be going on farther.

29. But they constrained Him, saying, "Stay with us, for it is toward evening, and the day is declining." And He entered in *as if* to stay with them.

30. And it came to pass, as He sat *at the table* with them, He took the bread *and* blessed *it*; and after breaking *it*, He gave *it* to them.

31. Then their eyes were opened, and they knew Him; and He disappeared from them.

32. And they said to one another, "Did not our hearts burn within us as He was speaking to us on the road, while He was opening the Scriptures to us?"

33. And they rose up that very hour *and* returned to Jerusalem; and they found the eleven and those with them assembled together,

34. Saying, "In truth, the Lord has risen! And He has appeared to Simon."

35. Then they related the things that had

happened *to them* on the road, and how He was known to them in the breaking of the bread.

36. Now as they were telling these things, Jesus Himself stood in their midst and said to them, "Peace *be* to you."

37. But they were terrified and filled with fear, thinking *that* they beheld a spirit.

38. Then He said to them, "Why are you troubled? And why do doubts come up in your hearts?"

39. See My hands and My feet, that it is I. Touch Me and see *for yourselves*; for a spirit does not have flesh and bones, as you see Me having."

40. And after saying this, He showed them *His* hands and *His* feet.

41. But while they were still disbelieving and wondering for joy, He said to them, "Do you have anything here to eat?"

42. Then they gave Him part of a broiled fish and a *piece* of honeycomb.

43. And He took these *and* ate in their presence.

44. And He said to them, "These *are* the words that I spoke to you when I was yet with you, that all *the* things which were written concerning Me in the Law of Moses and *in the* Prophets and *in the* Psalms must be fulfilled."

45. Then He opened their minds to understand the Scriptures,

46. And said to them, "According as it is written, it was necessary for the Christ to suffer, and to rise from *the* dead the third day.

47. And in His name, repentance and remission of sins should be preached to all nations, beginning at Jerusalem.

48. For you are witnesses of these things.

49. And behold, I send the promise of My Father upon you; but remain in the city of Jerusalem until you have been clothed with power from on high."

50. Then He led them out as far as Bethany; and He lifted up His hands *and* blessed them.

51. And it came to pass *that* as He was blessing them, He was separated from them and was carried up into heaven.

52. And after worshiping Him, they returned to Jerusalem with great joy,

53. And were continually in the temple, praising and blessing God. Amen.
